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# English Lessons



We know how important it is for each individual student to find their own path in language learning. We use a wide range of methods to engage and stimulate our students. This is why we have created a curriculum based on the students' age, level and needs, structured into three different programmes:

## Fun

(ages 8-11)

Highly engaging lessons that offer a wide range of material and activities specific for our young learners. It makes games into lessons and lessons into games.

## Connection

(ages 11-14)

Very dynamic lessons that include a variety of topics and media, especially designed to reflect the quick-paced interactive world our younger students are growing up in. Available in levels A1-C1.

## Action

(ages 14-17)

Lessons specifically designed to engage our older students through more abstract tasks, topics and contemporary issues. Available in levels A1-C1.

## Placement Tests

We offer classes at all levels from Elementary to Advanced. Students take a placement test on their first day of lessons to ensure they are placed at the correct level\*. We also offer a specific test for students with special needs.

## Examinations

We offer the option of taking the Trinity College London Graded Examination in Spoken English (GESE) on site for courses of 10 days or longer.\*\*

## Year-round Programmes

We can offer alternative, bespoke English language lessons for our ministay groups. We can deliver a range of English for Specific Purposes courses on request so please contact the team to discuss your group's requirements.

**The Connection and Action programmes consist of three different lessons a day:**

### TBL (Task-Based Learning)

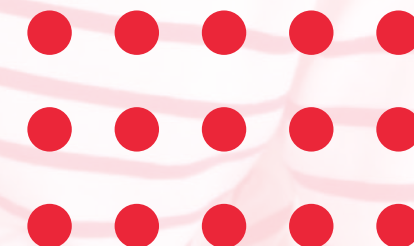
During these lessons students are encouraged to complete a task. Language is therefore acquired through the task as it emerges naturally as the result of the students' communicative needs.

### S&S (Skills and Systems)

These lessons aim to empowering our students' linguistic awareness and capabilities by working on all language skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking) and systems (grammar, phonology, lexis, discourse), as well as using materials relevant to exam preparation (KET, PET, FCE, CAE, TOEFL, IELTS, GESE).

### CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning)

These lessons merge CLIL and British Culture. Students learn about art, literature, and science, or about the history and the geography of the UK, while activating their linguistic knowledge.



Students are taught in class sizes up to 16.

\*Due to the variability of students' test results, a single class may occasionally include students of slightly different levels.

\*\*Minimum of 10 students across all groups required to source an examiner.



# Accommodation



At UKLC we provide full-board accommodation at all of our centres with options to suit all preferences and budgets. We know that choosing the right accommodation option is as important as the right programme and our team are here to guide you through the choices. We work very closely with our accommodation partners to deliver safe and comfortable accommodation for our students and group leaders.

## Homestay

Our homestay option gives students the experience of living in a British home and being fully immersed in English. Students get to know their hosts during their stay and learn about a new culture. Travel passes are provided for students and they are given detailed instructions for travelling to the school.

During the summer, breakfasts and evening meals are provided by our hosts and lunches are on site or packed lunches on excursion days. For ministay groups lunches are provided by the hosts.

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# Welfare

As specialists in programmes for young people aged 8-17, the safeguarding of children is fundamental to the way UKLC views and ensures the well-being of its students. We are recognised for our strengths in this area having developed robust systems and processes for managing the welfare of children in our centres.

## Steps we take to ensure the welfare of students;

- All staff undergo appropriate background and safeguarding checks.
- A dedicated Safeguarding and Welfare Coordinator at every site during the summer. For year-round groups our Ministay Coordinators manage safeguarding and welfare support.
- All students are given an induction lesson highlighting the rules for their centre and all group leaders attend an induction meeting when they arrive which details their responsibilities.
- We work with group leaders to ensure their students have a safe and enjoyable stay, taking full responsibility for students when they are in lessons and on scheduled activities. We assist group leaders to ensure students' safety and care outside of scheduled activities and during excursions.
- UKLC staff are available 24 hours a day for any issue that may arise and there is a 24-hour emergency number for partners, parents and students.
- All students get a UKLC wristband and lanyard to be worn at all times.
- Individuals are allocated to a member of UKLC staff who will act as their group leader and point of reference at all times (summer only).
- Our Operations and Safeguarding Handbook is distributed to all staff and is available to download on the website. Policies and procedures for welfare and safeguarding are available on our website and in our downloadable handbooks.

## Student Resilience and Wellbeing

Whilst the physical welfare and safety of our students has always been important, we believe that we need to focus on their mental welfare too. In recent years there has been a greater awareness of mental health in young people. An experience away from home, especially in current global climate, is an opportunity to strengthen that.

Along with sessions on General Safety and e-Safety, we have introduced a new session for every student. We dedicate lesson time to "Resilience and Well-being". It will help students to process the ever-changing world around them and their ability to adapt to it. We also offer them ideas and tools to manage their own well-being.



# Summer Schools

UKLC summer schools provide students with an unforgettable experience here in the UK. The programme includes 15 hours of English lessons with a full programme of excursions and activities for students to enjoy. English Plus programmes are available for students to tailor-make their learning journey.

# Programmes

In the summer we offer a range of programmes for students.

## London Centres:

All of our London Centres run an English plus London Explorer Programme

- 15 hours of General English Lessons per week
- Full excursion programme including 5 half day excursions per week and 3 full day excursions over two weeks.

## Other Centres:

In all our other centres we run an English Plus Programme

- 15 hours of General English Lessons per week
- 9 hours of English Plus Lessons per week
- 1 full day excursion and 2 half day excursions per week or 3 full day excursions and 3 half day excursions over two weeks (centre dependant)

## What's included:

- Full-board accommodation in residence or homestay
- Full programme of excursions, activities and evening entertainment\*
- Elective 'English Plus' activities
- Evening conversation clubs
- 1 free group leader for 15 students
- Placement Test on arrival and End-of-Course Certificate

## English Plus Options



### Multi-Activity

A wide variety of activities and sports which can include tennis, basketball, volleyball, swimming, photography workshops, dance, football, drama etc. Students take part in two or three activities on rotation in each session.



### Dance

Sessions are led by a specialist dance teacher and the programme works towards an end-of-course performance. Sessions begin with a warm up before the introduction of new steps and techniques followed by rehearsals for the final performance. Styles can include street dance, modern jazz, contemporary and West End musical.



### Drama

For students with an interest in drama and a desire to improve their English through confidence-building performances. Sessions are led by a teacher who will guide the students through a programme exploring various elements of acting, including improvisation, mime and role play.



### Football

Coaching sessions are led by qualified coaches and aim to improve each student's technical skills and abilities. Students will also build on their understanding of match tactics and playing systems. There are regular small-sided matches and a competition.



### Intensive English

This programme consists of additional English lessons for those who really want to maximise their language learning during their stay in the UK. Students will build on the knowledge acquired in their curricular lessons through extra classes taught according to age and level.



### Life Skills

The aim of this programme is to prepare for future studies and careers. Students undertake seminars and workshops on topics such as CV writing, interview skills, presentation skills and writing for academic purposes. Students engage in different media-based projects including journalism, social media, advertising, and media production.

#### Programme Notes:

- These programmes vary at each centre. Details of which programmes run at each centre can be found on the 'At a Glance Page' and each individual centre page
- Students who have not selected a programme by 31st May or who enrol after that will join the Multi-Activity programme.
- All students aged 8-10 will join a Multi-Activity programme.
- A minimum of 10 students applies to each programme and each student will be asked to select a 1st and 2nd option before arrival which they will join for the duration of their stay.
- For year-round groups these English Plus options can be added to the programme dependant on availability.
- At some centres we run a zig-zag programme. This will be confirmed on the programme sent out prior to arrival.
- Intensive English: Allocation is dependent on the age, number and levels of students. The levels will be broader than the main curriculum classes. Where an appropriate class isn't available students will be offered an alternative programme

\*Residential students do a full programme of evening activities. Homestay students spend their evenings with their hosts and do two evening activities per week at the centre.



# Evening Activities



In the evenings our Activity Teams deliver fun and engaging activities for students to practice their English and make new friends. Evening activities are included in all summer programmes and can be added into year-round programmes on request.

## Activities can include:

### Oscars Night

Students watch a number of scenes from selected films and re-enact the famous scenes. Creating their own script in English and costumes. Scenes are then shown on a big screen for everyone to enjoy and awards are given for the best reproduction.

### Speed Dating

Students socialise and get to know each other whilst improving their spoken English. They are given a short period of time to talk about their interests, families and hobbies. When the bell rings they swap and speak to another student.

### Talent Show

Gives students the opportunity to perform talents such as singing, dancing and acting in front of the rest of the centre. Judges score the performances and give positive feedback to each student who performs on the evening.

### 'Trashion' Show

Fashion with a recycled edge! Students are given a random selection of items to create new outfits and designs. Complete with a catwalk and judges.

### Disco

Students get to socialise and dance to new and classic music played by the DJ at the disco.

### Conversation Clubs

For older students or those who want to focus on developing their language skills they can join a conversation club and discuss interesting topics and issues whilst getting to know other students.

This is an example of evening activities provided at our centres. Students are provided with their evening activity programme on their first day.

Residential students do a full programme of evening activities. Homestay students spend their evenings with their hosts and do two evening activities per week at the centre.

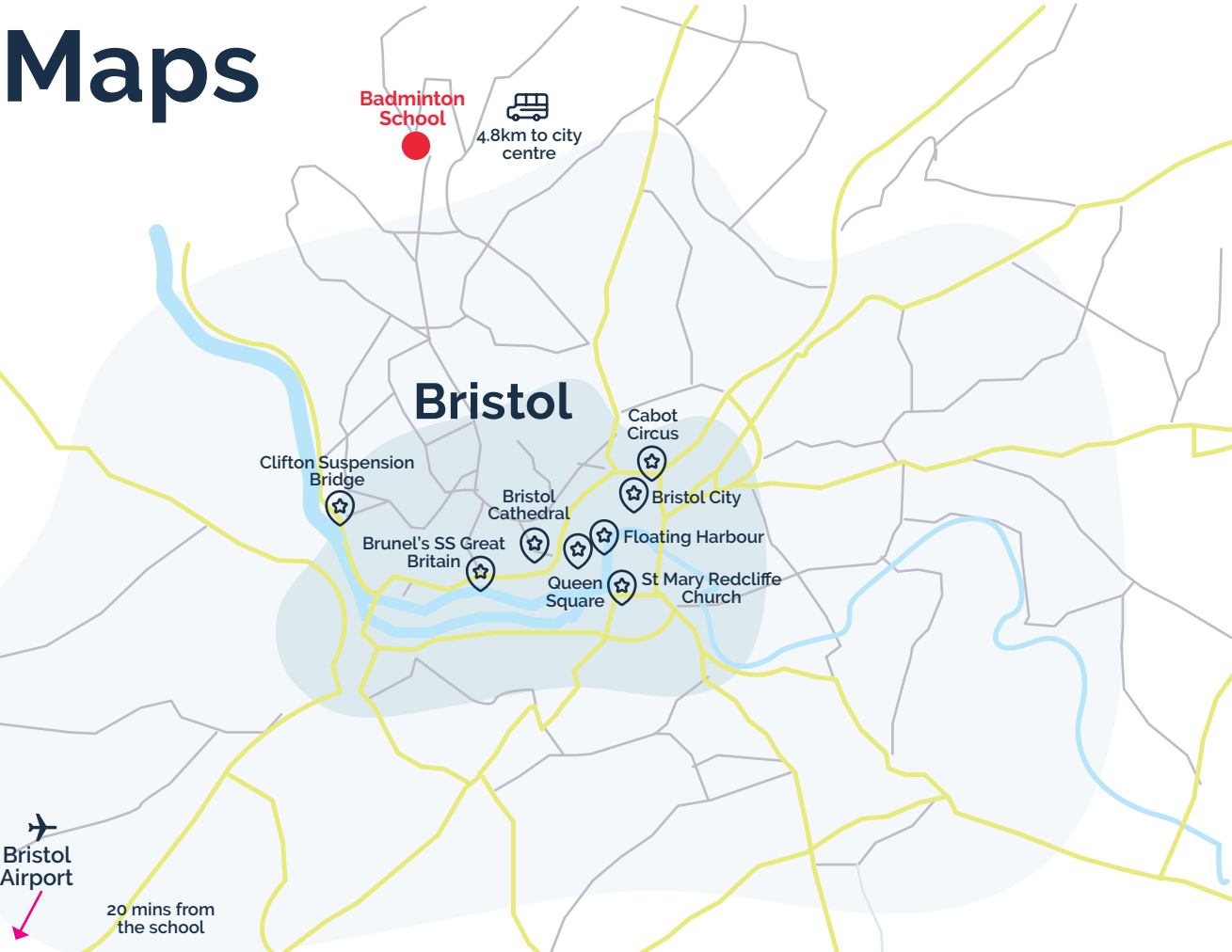

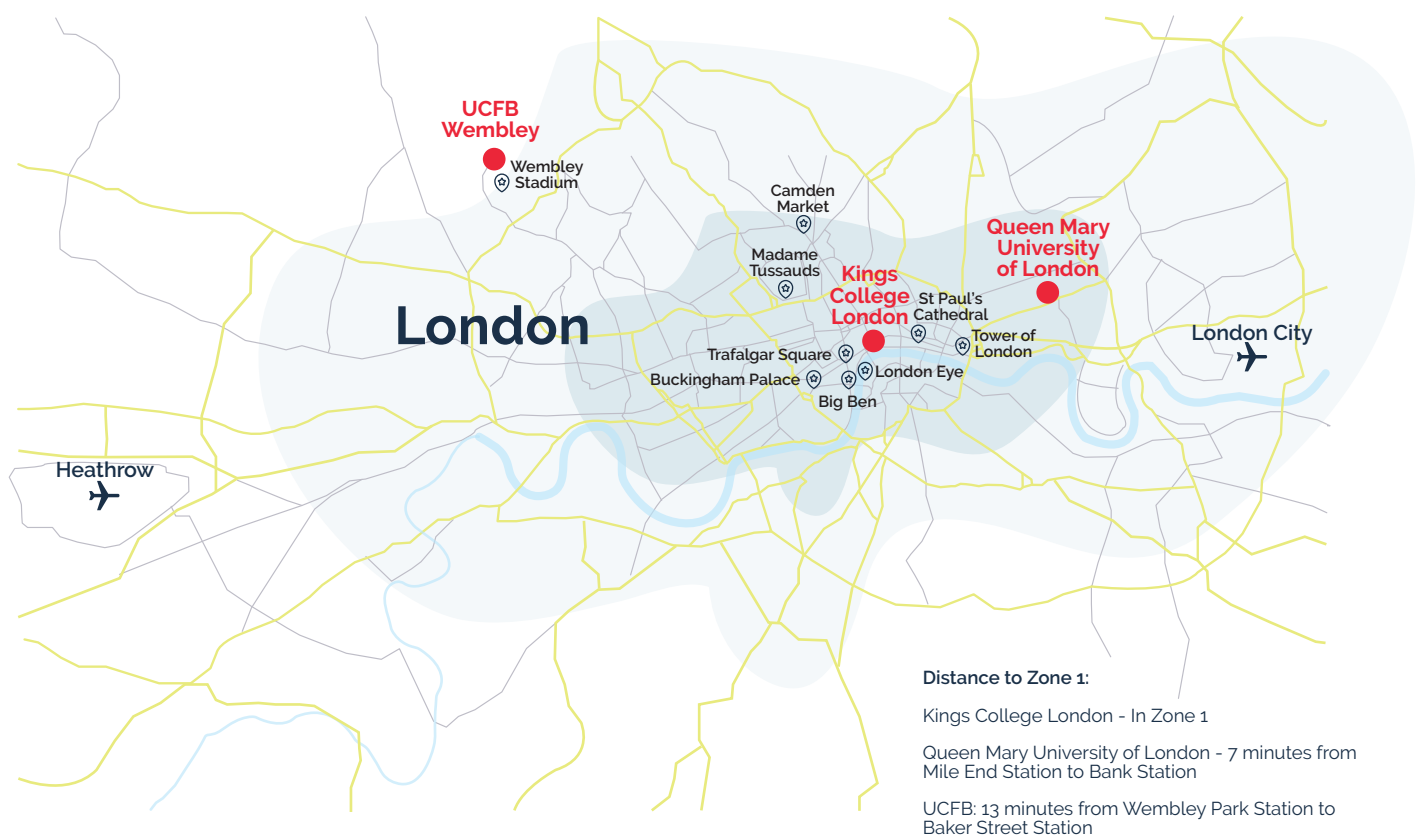
