The Centre

Clifton College is a boarding school in Southwest England which was founded in 1862. It boasts a wide collection of facilities with 100 acres of sport grounds including tennis courts, a swimming pool, football pitches and gyms. The buildings across the campus are a mixture of old and new and include Grade 2 listed buildings giving this centre a real traditional English boarding school feel.

The Location

The college is situated in Clifton which is a quiet suburb 2 miles from Bristol city centre. The city is famous for its art, culture and heritage. Students can explore the many things to do here including visiting the SS Great Britain, enjoying the art galleries and the M Shed Museum, shopping, and exploring the cobbled streets looking for street art. The Programme

The programme at Clifton College is specially designed to connect the English Lessons with the full day excursions to give students a fully immersive experience. It includes:

- A weekly theme (sample themes included the environment, marketing, entertainment and politics)
- English language tuition (20 hours per week) including English Experience Lessons (14 hours) and Electives (6 hours)
- 2 full day excursions per week plus a local visit day in Bristol
- Evening activities every night
- Daily “Brain Exercises”
- Daily “House Exchanges”

Full Day Excursions Include:

- London with a visit to Shakespeare’s Globe
- London with a visit to the Houses of Parliament
- Cadburys World
- Windsor Castle and Hampton Court
- Outdoor team building activity days (including Kayaking, Abseiling and Raft Building) English Experience

English Experience Lessons

Students develop problem solving skills whilst developing their English language. The topics are designed to engage students in multidisciplinary work that reflects practices they will experience at work or university. As such, this course improves students’ confidence and their ability to communicate about various topics.

Electives

Students can choose from various different activities including:

- News Reporting
- Public Speaking
- Debating (mini UN)
- Tennis / golf / football coaching
- Cambridge Exam Preparation
- Grammar workshops
- Comic book writing

Brain exercises

Movement is so important to learning that we incorporate it throughout programme. Brain exercises are our specific times for exercises designed to increase focus and engagement.

Multi-Activity

Students can choose a different activity each day including:

- Team or individual sports
- Baking
- Board games
- Book club
- Yoga
- Nature walks
- Drawing
- Time for rest and reflection

House exchanges

Making new friends and learning about different cultures is a huge part of the summer school experience, and this is the time we allocate specifically for our students to get to know their roommates and classmates better.
