- ✓ Attend the pre-summer online training.

During the Course:

- ✓ Meet and greet students at the airport and accompany them to the centre as required.
- ✓ Assist with the placement testing and the marking of tests.
- ✓ Attend and contribute positively to all team meetings.
- ✓ Prepare lessons to a high standard to suit the needs of the students using the materials provided.
- ✓ Create a positive learning environment and take all necessary measures to ensure students get the most out of the lessons and enjoy themselves.
- ✓ Place great emphasis on oral communication both inside and outside the classroom.

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Working Hours:

A Full Time Teacher is required to work 22 sessions per fortnight based on a six-day working week. A session is defined as approximately three hours in the morning, afternoon or evening. A full-time teacher will teach two sessions a day on the days where lessons take place. A full-day excursion is two sessions. Airport transfers may be considered as one or two sessions depending on the duration.

In some centres teaching may take place at weekends and it may be necessary for teachers to work on six consecutive days.
