# English Lessons



We know how important it is for each individual student to find their own path in language learning. We use a wide range of methods to engage and stimulate our students. This is why we have created a curriculum based on the students' age, level and needs, structured into three different programmes:

## Fun (ages 8-10)

Engaging lessons that offer a wide range of materials and activities specific for our young learners, making games into lessons and lessons into games. Available in levels A1-B1.

## Connection (ages 10-13)

Dynamic lessons covering a variety of topics and media, designed to engage students using tools native to the fast-paced world they are growing up in. Available in levels A1-C1.

## Action (ages 13-16)

Lessons tailored for learners stepping into their teenage years. This programme focuses on activating students' knowledge and competencies to balance developing a personal voice while contributing effectively to a team. Available in levels A1-C2.

## Purpose (ages 16-18)

Lessons tailored for our students approaching adulthood, designed to kickstart their lives not only as maturing youths but also as forward-thinking global citizens. Available in levels A1-C2.

These ranges provide a reference point and are not absolute. Changes will be made when appropriate based on class sizes and student's ages and abilities.

### The Connection, Action and Purpose programmes consist of three different lessons a day:

#### Focus on Language

These lessons aim to empower our students' linguistic awareness and capabilities by working on all language skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking) and systems (grammar, phonology, lexis, discourse), as well as using materials relevant to exam preparation (KET, PET, FCE, CAE, TOEFL, IELTS, GESE).

#### Focus on Leadership

This programme is designed to equip students with essential 21st-century skills, focusing on leadership development, communication and teamwork. Students build the confidence and competencies needed to grow into empowered young adults.

#### Focus on Culture

These lessons combine CLIL and British culture, allowing students to use English to explore a range of disciplines, including art, literature, natural sciences, as well as the history and geography of the UK.

## Placement Tests

We offer classes at all levels from Elementary to Advanced. Students take a placement test before starting to ensure they are placed at the correct level.\* We also offer a specific test for students with special needs.

## Examinations

We offer the option of taking the Trinity College London Graded Examination in Spoken English (GESE) on site for courses of 10 days or longer.\*\*

## Year-round Programmes

We can offer alternative, bespoke English language lessons for our ministay groups. We can deliver a range of English for Specific Purposes courses on request so please contact the team to discuss your group's requirements.

We run a zigzag programme in some centres so lessons may also take place in the afternoons. This will be confirmed on your final programme which you will receive prior to arrival.

Students who are on the Fun academic programme do a different structure of lessons designed especially for younger learners.

Students are taught in class sizes up to 16.

# Accommodation



At UKLC we provide full-board accommodation at all of our centres with options to suit different preferences and budgets. We know that choosing the right accommodation option is as important as the right programme and our team are here to guide you through the choices. We work closely with our accommodation partners to deliver safe and comfortable accommodation for our students and group leaders.

## Homestay

Our homestay option gives students the experience of living in a British home and being fully immersed in English. Students get to know their hosts during their stay and learn about a new culture. Travel passes are provided for students and they are given detailed instructions for travelling to the school.

Breakfasts and evening meals are provided by the hosts at the homestay. For lunch students are provided with packed lunches from the hosts.

In York and Bristol, we work closely with trusted homestay partners to provide students with safe and welcoming accommodation. In Chester the homestay accommodation is provided by our sister company Linguastay.

## Residence

Most of our residences are onsite and easily accessible from the classrooms, social spaces and canteen. We have a mix of university accommodation and boarding school accommodation depending on the centre. Across our different schools we have single, twin and multibedded rooms, some with en-suite bathrooms and some shared.

# Welfare

As specialists in programmes for young people aged 8-18, the safeguarding of children is fundamental to the way UKLC views and ensures the well-being of its students. We have developed robust systems and processes for managing the welfare of children in our centres.

## Steps we take to ensure the welfare of students;

- All staff undergo appropriate background and safeguarding checks.
- A dedicated Safeguarding and Welfare Coordinator at every site during the summer. For year-round groups our Ministay Coordinators manage safeguarding and welfare support.
- All students are given an induction lesson highlighting the rules for their centre and all group leaders attend an induction meeting when they arrive which details their responsibilities.
- We work with group leaders to ensure their students have a safe and enjoyable stay, taking full responsibility for students when they are in lessons and on scheduled activities. We assist group leaders to ensure students' safety and care outside of scheduled activities and during excursions.
- UKLC staff are available 24 hours a day for any issue that may arise and there is a 24-hour emergency number for partners, parents and students.
- All students get a UKLC wristband and lanyard to be worn at all times.
- Our Operations and Safeguarding Handbook is distributed to all staff and is available to download on the website. Policies and procedures for welfare and safeguarding are available on our website and in our downloadable handbooks.

## Student Resilience and Wellbeing

Whilst the physical welfare and safety of our students has always been important, we believe that we need to focus on their mental welfare too. In recent years there has been a greater awareness of mental health in young people. An experience away from home, especially in current global climate, is an opportunity to strengthen that.

Along with sessions on General Safety and e-Safety, we have introduced a new session for every student. We dedicate lesson time to "Resilience and Well-being". It will help students to process the ever-changing world around them and their ability to adapt to it. We also offer them ideas and tools to manage their own well-being.

# Programmes

In the summer we offer a range of programmes for students.

## London Centres:

All of our London Centres run an English plus London Explorer Programme

- 15 hours of English tuition per week
- Full excursion programme including 5 half day excursions per week and 3 full day excursions over two weeks

## English Plus Centres:

In our other centres we run an English Plus Programme

- 15 hours of English tuition per week
- 9 hours of English Plus Lessons per week
- 1 full day excursion and 2 half day excursions per week or 3 full day excursions and 3 half day excursions over two weeks (centre dependant)

## What's included:

- Full-board accommodation in residence or homestay
- Full programme of excursions, activities and evening entertainment\*
- Elective 'English Plus' activities\*\*
- 1 free group leader for 15 students
- Placement Test on arrival and End-of-Course Certificate

### Programme Notes:

- These programmes vary at each centre. Details of which programmes run at each centre can be found on the 'At a Glance Page' and each individual centre page
- Students who have not selected a programme by 31st May or who enrol after that will join the Multi-Activity programme or City Explorer (Manchester only).
- All students aged 8-10 will join a Multi-Activity programme (City Explorer in Manchester).
- A minimum of 10 students applies to each programme and each student will be asked to select a 1st and 2nd option before arrival which they will join for the duration of their stay. For year-round groups these English Plus options can be added to the programme dependant on availability.
- At some centres we run a zig-zag programme. This will be confirmed on the programme sent out prior to arrival.
- Intensive English: Allocation is dependent on the age, number and levels of students. The levels will be broader than the main curriculum classes. Where an appropriate class isn't available, students will be offered an alternative programme

\*Residential students do a full programme of evening activities. Homestay students will do 2 evening activities per week and spend the rest of the evenings with their hosts.

\*\*In the London centres, students do a London Explorer Programme. At all other centres students can choose between the English Plus options available at their centre.

\*\*\* Please note that we run a zig-zag programme in some centres so lessons may also take place in the afternoons. This will be confirmed on the final programme which students will receive prior to arrival. These times are a sample and may vary across each centre. Groups will be advised of their mealtimes when on site.

# English Plus Options



## Multi-Activity

A variety of activities and sports which can include tennis, basketball, volleyball, swimming, photography workshops, dance, football, drama etc. Students take part in two or three activities on rotation in each session. One session per week will focus on photography and vlogging.



## Performing Arts

During these sessions, students passionate about dancing, acting, or singing will immerse themselves in hands-on training designed to unleash their creative potential on any kind of stage. They will not only develop their talents but also experience the thrill of live performance, collaboration, and artistic expression.



## Football

Coaching sessions are led by qualified coaches and aim to improve each student's technical skills and abilities. Students will also build on their understanding of match tactics and playing systems. There are regular small-sided matches and a competition.



## Intensive English (Community Building)

Based on UKLC's integral community-building approach, these additional lessons aim to help students develop an active role in the school as a thriving community, with its challenges, complexities and opportunity for collective growth.



## London Explorer

In our London summer centres, students go on an exciting trip every day to explore the city. They visit famous places, learn about London, and enjoy new experiences with friends.



## City Explorer (Manchester)

Students take part in outdoor learning sessions around the city. They complete challenges, speak to local people, discover more about Manchester, and practise their English in real-life situations. One session per week will focus on photography or vlogging.



# Evening Activities



In the evenings our Activity Teams deliver fun and engaging activities for students to practise their English and make new friends. Evening activities are included on our summer programmes and can be added into year-round programmes on request.

## Activities can include:

### Oscars Night

Students watch a number of scenes from selected films and re-enact the famous scenes. Creating their own script in English and costumes. scenes are then shown on a big screen for everyone to enjoy and awards are given for the best reproduction.

### Red vs Blue

An activity with a competitive edge! Students are split into two even teams; red and blue. They battle through a number of fun challenges, activities and party games to be crowned the champions.

### Lip Sync Battle

As seen on TV, lip sync battles are fun and a great way to get the students involved. Two students will lip sing to the same song, at the same time to win over the audience and gain their vote. An expressive and engaging activity.

### Talent Show

Gives students the opportunity to perform talents such as singing, dancing and acting in front of the rest of the centre. Judges score the performances and give positive feedback to each student who performs on the evening.

### 'Trashion' Show

Fashion with a recycled edge! Students are given a random selection of items to create new outfits and designs. Complete with a catwalk and judges.

### Disco

Students get to socialise and dance to new and classic music played by the DJ at the disco.

### Conversation Clubs

For older students or those who want to focus on developing their language skills they can join a conversation club and discuss interesting topics and issues whilst getting to know other students.

This is an example of evening activities provided at our centres. Students are provided with their evening activity programme on their first day.

Homestay students will do 2 evening activities per week and spend the rest of the evenings with their hosts.

## Clifton College

### The Centre

Clifton College is a boarding school in Southwest England which was founded in 1862. It boasts a wide collection of facilities with 100 acres of sport grounds including tennis courts, a swimming pool, football pitches and gyms. The buildings across the campus are a mixture of old and new and include Grade 2 listed buildings giving this centre a real traditional English boarding school feel.

### The Location

The college is situated in Clifton which is a quiet suburb 2 miles from Bristol city centre. The city is famous for its art, culture and heritage. Students can explore the many things to do here including visiting the SS Great Britain, enjoying the art galleries and the M Shed Museum, shopping, and exploring the cobbled streets looking for street art. ### The Centre
